Please allow seven (7) business days for the request to be reviewed. Approval for the CVISN Portal may include access to the Virtual Weigh-In-Motion (VWIM) sites, which will require a separate login and password. Once the request has been processed and approved, users will receive separate emails containing their username(s), password(s), and instructions.

Users must submit an updated form annually to maintain access. A reminder email and form will be sent approximately 30 days prior to the account's expiration date.

Authorization
