

Reading the Outcomes Map

Positive or Negative outcome:

Relative to the goal, emerging technologies are likely to move the dial in a positive or negative direction in the next 20-30 years without new policy intervention.


Length represents the range of possible outcomes.

Example: Emerging technology in the form of autonomous vehicles is likely to reduce deaths and serious injuries on our roadways.

Certain or uncertain outcome:

Relative to the goal, the level of confidence with which the team can predict the outcome. Mapping does not reflect a range of uncertainty.

Example: We are relatively certain that emerging technology in the form of autonomous vehicles is likely to reduce deaths and serious injuries because research is already proving these outcomes and they can be achieved with partial adoption/deployment.
