

OTP Amendment 1

The Oregon Transportation Commission approved two new Oregon Transportation Plan Performance Measures on August 13, 2026. ODOT has amended the OTP section 7.6 - Transportation Performance Monitoring to incorporate this change removing the previous equity performance measures. The equity performance measures in section 7.6.2 – Key Performance Targets for the OTP have been updated to reflect the recently adopted performance measures with the following:

- Reduce disparities in fatality and serious injury rates.
- Reduce disparities in multimodal access to essential destinations.

Measure 1 – Traffic Safety

Traffic Safety: Reduce disparities in fatality and serious injury rates.

Data shows that some groups of people experience higher rates of fatal and serious injury crashes. Understanding these disparities and what causes them is key to reducing them. This performance measure builds toward a related one in the Oregon Transportation Plan: *“Eliminate traffic fatalities and serious injuries.”*

Measure 2 – Access to Destinations

Access to Destinations: Reduce disparities in multimodal access to essential destinations.

Not everyone has equal access to everyday destinations like work, school or the grocery store. People can be limited by where they live, how they travel, or their personal demographics. Measuring disparities in access to destinations helps us understand their underlying causes and leads to strategies to reduce those disparities.
