If selected for the Policy Coordinating Committee, ODOT will work with each member to determine eligibility and appropriate compensation.

ODOT is updating the Oregon Transportation Plan, last updated in 2006. The Oregon Transportation Plan is the overarching policy element of the state transportation system plan. The intent of the update is to provide the long-range vision, goals, policies, and strategies that shape Oregon's multimodal transportation system through 2050.

The committee's primary purpose is to bring diverse interests and insights from across the state to help advise the project team and the Oregon Transportation Commission. The Policy Coordinating Committee members will review project information and inform how ODOT decisions in the plan can affect other efforts and identify potential policy inconsistencies. Committee members will serve between 18-24 months and meet approximately every 2 months.
