## **Task Force Objective**

The purpose of the task force is to develop a design for revenue collection for Oregon's roads and highways that will replace the current system for revenue collection.

## Goals for 2024:

- Review Oregon State Highway Fund revenue streams with consideration of expected vehicle transition to alternative fuels
- Review alternative/non-traditional revenue mechanisms, including road usage charges, supplemental registration fees for high-efficiency vehicles, taxes on vehicle electricity use, and mileage-based taxes on medium-duty vehicles
- Develop recommendations and considerations for Legislature for potential inclusion in any 2025 transportation legislation
