

ODOT DAP EXCEPTION REQUEST:

ODOT Design Acceptance Phase (DAP) Exception Request is a deliverable required at Design Acceptance Phase when any of the required DAP checklist deliverables are outstanding (missing or incomplete) at DAP. The DAP Exception Request provides a description of the outstanding DAP deliverables and a plan for completion.

The Project Lead is responsible for completing this form in collaboration with project development team members (PDT), Technical Center Manager, and Area Manager. By signing the DAP Exception Request the Region Manager confirms his/her acceptance of the plan for mitigating the outstanding DAP phase gate deliverables.

Final DAP documents will be housed in Project Wise within the DAP folder and the template is posted on the <u>Project Delivery Guide site</u> and also in the <u>ProjectWise template folder</u>.

DAP Due Date	This is the date when Design Acceptance Phase is expected to be completed with all required deliverables. This date is assigned to the project when the project schedule is baselined at Project Initiation.
