About:

The purpose of the U.S.20: 3rd St. – 15th (Greenwood, Bend) project is to improve mobility, access, and safety for motorists, transit riders, pedestrians and bicyclists. While upgrading, replacing, and rehabilitating aging infrastructure within the corridor, and upgrading ADA ramps to current standards.

The project will construct ADA compliant sidewalks, curb ramps and driveways along the corridor, as well as a multi-use path along 3rd St., and a new enhanced pedestrian crossing with median island refuge will be provided at 4th Street/US20/Greenwood Avenue intersection.
