

Oregon 42: Lower Lookingglass Creek Bridge Repair

What is ODOT planning to do?

Oregon 42 (Coos Bay to Roseburg Highway) is one of the primary routes connecting Interstate 5 to the southern Oregon coast. The Lower Lookingglass Creek Bridge is located at milepost 72.5, near Douglas High School and the west entrance to Winston. More than 4,600 vehicles cross the bridge each day.

Built in 1949, the bridge is in need of several repairs. This



project will repair damaged concrete, strengthen and resurface the bridge deck, replace the bridge rails and connect them to guardrail and concrete barrier at each end of the bridge, adjust the

drains, make minor repairs to the timber sidewalk, and pave the roadway approaches.

Construction is scheduled for spring and summer 2019.

How will drivers be affected?

The bridge will be closed for up to four weeks during the summer to allow for repairs to the deck. During the closure, Oregon 42 traffic will detour through Dillard on Old Highway 99 and Brockway Road.

At other times, motorists can expect intermittent lane closures and delays.
