

CONSTRUCTION NOTICE

Trail closed between John B. Yeon Trailhead (Elowah Falls) and Toothrock Trailheads until summer 2026

The Historic Highway State Trail is temporarily closed between John B. Yeon Trailhead (Elowah Falls) and Toothrock Trailhead while we replace the eastbound bridge at McCord Creek. The trail is expected to reopen in summer 2026.

A temporary shuttle service is available for pedestrians and bicyclists using the trail while work is underway. The shuttle is ADA-accessible and has capacity for three bicycles. Plan for delays when using the shuttle.


Shuttle Pickup/Dropoff Locations: The Elowah Falls Trailhead and Toothrock Trailhead.

Shuttle Schedule: The shuttle operates around the clock (24 hours a day, 7 days a week). Service is available every 30 minutes between 8am and 8pm, and once every hour between 8pm and 8am.

Limited Bike Capacity: The shuttle has limited space for up to three bicycles at a time. Larger groups need to plan other alternatives to travel around the closure. Bicyclists and pedestrians must take the shuttle and are not allowed to use this segment of I-84 while work is underway.
