

OR 126: Linn County Line to Old McKenzie Highway

Lane County

Project Description

We're repaving and applying permanent striping on a section of OR 126.

Estimated Schedule

Design: 2022-2024

Construction: 2024

Purpose and Need

This section of road is within a snow zone. It experiences multiple freezing and thawing periods annually and heavy traffic using chains.

The weather and snow chains have damaged the road with potholes.

Our maintenance crew has had to apply patches more frequently to hold this section of road together.

Proposed Solutions

To repair and preserve this section of road, we'll remove the existing pavement and repave.

We'll add new permanent striping to the entire project area and adjust or replace guardrail where needed.

Anticipated Benefits

This work will help extend the roads useful life and give travelers a smoother ride.

Doing the work now before the road gets worse is more cost effective. This section will need less frequent repairs by our maintenance crews.

By preserving the road now, more costly repairs are not needed in the future.

Estimated Project Cost

Estimated total cost: \$4,441,600
