

# U.S. 95: MP36 - McDermitt

## Harney County

### Project Description

Resurface 85 miles of U.S. 95 to extend the life of the pavement.

### Anticipated Benefits

- Create a smooth ride.
- Extend life of highway.
- Reduce on-going maintenance.

### Purpose and Need

The current road surface is nearly 25 years old and in need of repair. This is the oldest and thinnest overlay segment from rehabilitation of U.S. 95 in the 1990s.

### Proposed Solutions

- Resurface highway with 4" asphalt overlay and chip seal.
- Restore pavement to original width of 32 feet.
- Replace centerline, shoulder rumble strips and striping.
