

# OR 42: U.S. 101 to Cedar Point Road

## Coos County

### Project Description

This project will resurface a seven-mile section of Oregon 42 west of Coquille, from Delmar Road to Cedar Point Road (milepost 2.7-9.7), repair four bridges, and design several culvert repairs and replacements.

### Purpose and Need

The last paving project in this area was in 2007. The road surface is raveling, cracking and developing potholes in several areas. Four bridges are also in need of resurfacing. More than two dozen culverts in this area are damaged and at risk of failure.

### Proposed Solutions

This project will resurface seven miles of Oregon 42 and repair four bridges. This project will also design more than two dozen culvert repairs or replacements along Oregon 42 between U.S. 101 and Cedar Point Road.

### Anticipated Benefits

- Preserve and protect the highway and bridges between Coquille and Coos Bay.
- Improve safety by providing a smooth road surface.
- Reduce maintenance costs related to frequent road repairs.
- Improve drainage and fish passage in this area.



This project is located on Oregon 42 between Coquille and the U.S. 101 junction.
