OR 224 at OR 211 and SE Burnett Rd.

Clackamas County

Project Description

Evaluate options for improving safety at the intersection of OR 224 with OR 211 and SE Burnett Rd. Develop a design based on evaluation findings, which could include improvements such as a roundabout, signalized intersection, lighting, sidewalks and signing.

Purpose And Need

This intersection is in the top 5% of intersections prioritized for safety improvements based on crash data. Between 2014 and 2018, 42 people were injured in 34 crashes. Roughly 45% of the crashes occurred under nighttime conditions. This project improves operations and safety at this intersection.

Proposed Solutions

A variety of solutions to improve safety will be evaluated and designed, and could include a roundabout, lighting, signs, storm drain system upgrades and culverts.

Anticipated Benefits

This project is for design only. The benefits will be realized with future construction funding and include:

- Reducing crashes and increasing safety for all travelers on OR 224 at OR 211 by improving traffic control, visibility, and delineation between travelers.
- Increasing safety and traveler comfort for people walking, biking or taking transit who often use the nearby Cazadero Trail and TriMet Line 30 by adding lighting, traffic calming and improved separation from cars.
