

OR 6: Milepoint 4.4-9.0

Tillamook County

Project Description

We're repaving and applying permanent striping on a section of OR 6.

Estimated Schedule

Design: 2023-2026
Construction: 2026

Purpose and Need

The existing pavement in this section is old and damaged. The driving surface is rough with cracks and pot holes.

Proposed Solutions

To repair and preserve this section of road, we'll grind down and remove the top driving surface and repave. We'll add new permanent striping and replace any deteriorated signs within the project area.

We'll replace the curb ramps at the bridge between Mills Bridge Road and Pete Street to make them ADA compliant. We'll also resurface the bridge around milepoint 6.9 and replace the bridge joints.

Anticipated Benefits

This work will help extend the useful life of the road and bridge deck, giving travelers a smoother ride.

Doing the work now before the road gets worse is more cost effective. This section will need less frequent repairs by our maintenance crews.

We're paving the bridge, creating a waterproof surface which helps protect it.

Installing ADA compliant curb ramps makes the area safer and more accessible whether you walk, ride or roll.
