

# I-5: Cottage Grove - Martin Creek

Lane County

## Project Description

We're repaving and applying permanent striping on a section of I-5 in both directions.

### Estimated Schedule

Design: 2023-2025

Construction: 2026

## Purpose and Need

The existing pavement in this section is damaged. The driving surface is rapidly cracking and will continue to do so to the point where our maintenance crews won't be able to repair.

There may be some locations where we'll need to fully dig out and rebuild the road base before repaving.

## Proposed Solutions

To repair and preserve this section of road, we'll remove the existing pavement and repave.

We'll also add new permanent striping within the project area and add back in the existing shoulder rumble strips.

We may also look at including a few ramps if budget allows.

## Anticipated Benefits

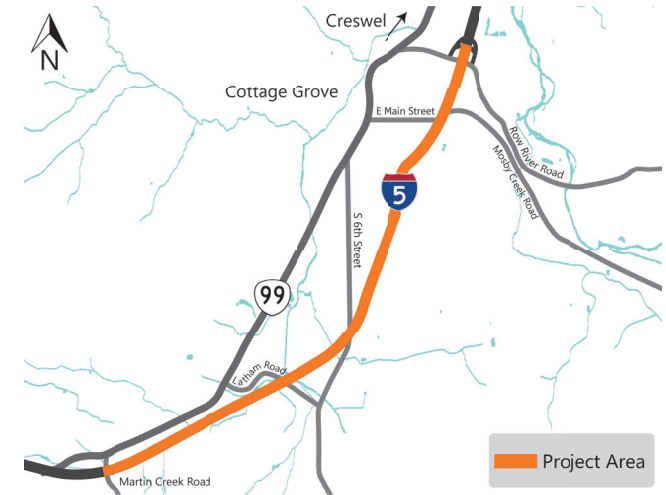
This work will help extend the roads useful life and give travelers a smoother ride.

Doing the work now before the road gets worse is more cost effective. This section will need less frequent repairs by our maintenance crews.

Rumble strips are grooves cut into the road that when driven over make a sound and vibration that alerts inattentive or drowsy drivers that they've drifted out of their lane.

## Estimated Project Cost

Estimated total cost: \$19,728,432
