

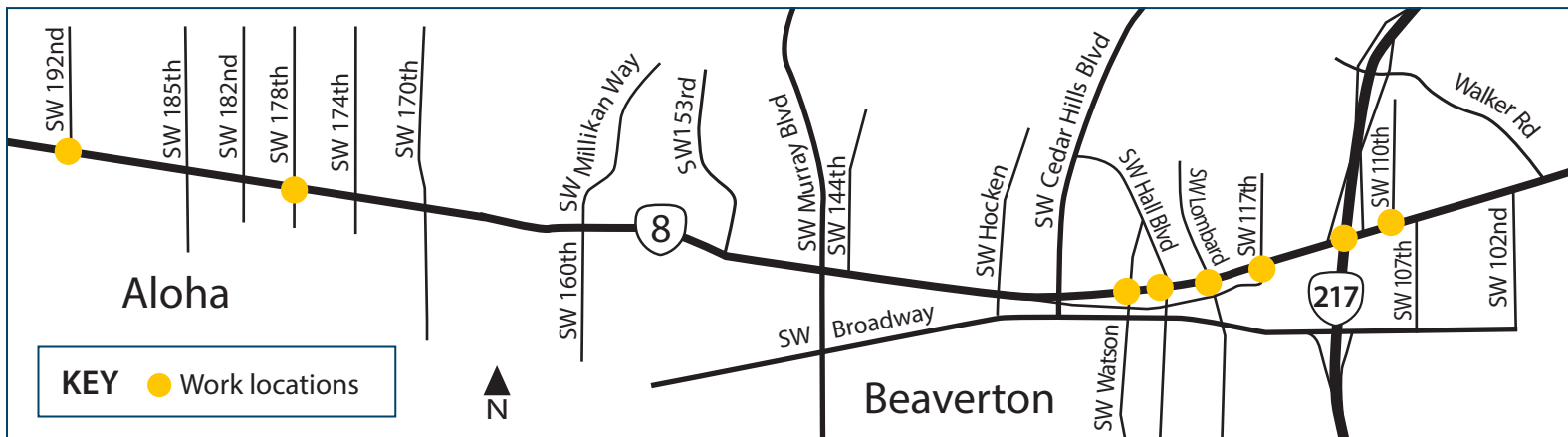
# OR 8: SW 110th Avenue to SW 192nd Avenue Improvement Project



AUGUST 2022

ODOT is starting construction this month on a project to improve traffic signals and pedestrian connectivity at eight intersections along Canyon Road (OR 8) in Beaverton and Aloha.

The majority of the work will conclude by the end of 2022. Construction at OR 8 and SW 110th Avenue will continue through summer 2023.



## Project Details

This project includes eight intersections in Beaverton and Aloha. Signal upgrades below include new traffic signal heads as well as pedestrian signals and countdown timers. Where needed, we will upgrade road signs and trim vegetation to improve visibility.

- **SW 110th Avenue, at the OR 217 northbound ramps, SW 117th Avenue/SW Broadway Street, SW Lombard Avenue, SW Hall Boulevard, SW Watson Avenue** – upgrading signals, rebuilding sidewalk curb ramps, building new sidewalk and a bike lane at 110th Avenue and adding new crosswalk striping across the northbound on-ramp to OR 217.
- **SW 178th Avenue** – adding new sidewalk and bus shelter on the north side of OR 8.
- **SW 192nd Avenue** – adding new enhanced crosswalk with a Rapid Flashing Beacon and pedestrian island, rebuilding sidewalk curb ramps, improving lighting and building a new concrete bus pad.

## Benefits

- Traffic signals that are more responsive to existing conditions, more visible and overall more functional.
- More accessible and safe highway connections for all sidewalk users.
- Expected crash reduction between vehicles and pedestrians with the new pedestrian activated beacon at SW 192nd Avenue.

## Construction Impacts

Traffic impacts may include short-term lane closures, periodic crosswalk and sidewalk closures and flaggers directing traffic. We will provide ADA-accessible pedestrian detours around the work zones. Night work is expected as there are limited hours in which the contractor can close a lane during the day due to travel volumes. Residents may hear some nighttime noise.
