OR 99W South Corvallis Facility Plan

Highway 99W in south Corvallis is the focus of a planning effort that will determine how best to improve safety and mobility along this corridor. The Facility Plan is led by Oregon Department of Transportation in close collaboration with the City of Corvallis. Planning is underway and is expected to continue into early 2022.



The OR 99W South Corvallis Facility Plan is developing and evaluating options for the future of the corridor.

Project Update

In spring and early summer 2021, the project team:

- Evaluated the current conditions along the 99W Corridor in south Corvallis
- Developed corridor goals, desired outcomes, guiding principles, and a vision for the project
- Forecast what conditions may be like in 2040

Thanks to community participation in our first Virtual Open House the team also identified needs, challenges, and opportunities along the corridor.

We completed a concept development workshop in July and will be sharing more about those concepts in late August.

The project team, technical advisory committee, and stakeholder advisory group came together in late July to develop potential design solutions for improving the Highway 99W corridor in south Corvallis.

During the workshop, the group will be mapped out the future of the corridor and considered options for:

- Restructuring intersections, such as adding roundabouts and signals
- Providing comfortable and safe options for people walking, biking, and taking transit
- Evaluating options for medians, street trees, and pedestrian crossings

Following the workshop, the project team presented the design ideas to the public.


