



# WHAT'S HAPPENING ON OUTER POWELL?

The Oregon Department of Transportation (ODOT) is helping people get around busy Outer SE Powell Boulevard more safely. The Outer Powell Transportation Safety Project stretches between I-205 and the Portland/Gresham city limits, just east of SE 174th Avenue. Planned safety improvements will reduce both the frequency and severity of crashes and help vehicles, pedestrians, transit and bicyclists share the road with fewer conflicts.

Construction began along SE Powell Boulevard from SE 122nd Avenue to SE 136th Avenue in early 2019 and will continue through October 2020. ODOT is now designing safety improvements for the remainder of the corridor in addition to the section currently under construction.

# **ODOT IS MAKING IMPROVEMENTS TO ENHANCE SAFETY**

Storm drains to prevent water from pooling on the road




Lighting for improved visibility

# **UNDER CONSTRUCTION NOW**

While improvements are constructed, people traveling along the corridor can expect:



Traffic maintained on Powell Boulevard, but side streets may be restricted to local access.



Businesses open during construction. While access may be limited, don't let that stop you from visiting local businesses.



Relocated or temporarily closed bus stops (check TriMet.org/alerts for up-to-date information).



Some noise increases throughout construction, but ODOT will work to keep it at a minimum.



Occasional weekend and nighttime bike lane closures.

# **DESIGN PHASE**




The Oregon Department of Transportation is now in the design phase for the remainder of the corridor:

- I-205 to SE 122nd Avenue
- SE 136th Avenue to just east of SE 174th Avenue (the Portland/Gresham city limits)

ODOT expects the design of these two segments to be complete at the end of 2022, and construction is scheduled to begin in early 2023. ODOT will aim to design the improvements for the remaining sections to be consistent with the section currently under construction between SE 122nd Avenue and SE 136th Avenue.

## **DRIVEWAY AND ACCESS CHANGES**

If you live, work or own property on SE Powell Boulevard between I-205 and SE 122nd Avenue, or between SE 136th Avenue and just east of SE 174th Avenue, you may experience some changes to your driveway, parking or access. If ODOT is considering making changes to your property or business, a project team member will contact you in the near future to explain the process.
