February tree removal

Before March 1, crews will remove trees in the project area. Removing or trimming trees is necessary to allow drivers to see pedestrians and bicyclists in crosswalks or waiting to cross Powell. Trees must be removed before March to avoid impacting nesting birds.

Impacts

For tree removal, travelers should expect to see daytime and nighttime lane closures. Some work must be done during the day to avoid excess nighttime noise.

Throughout the project, people walking or cycling in the workzone along Powell Boulevard will encounter detours. Detour routes will be clearly marked and accessible for people with disabilities. During construction, TriMet bus stops may be temporarily relocated and/or routes detoured. For information about bus stops and routes, please visit TriMet.org/alerts.

Upcoming construction

This spring crews will begin construction on the other project elements. Construction will continue through early 2019. More information about traffic impacts will be available on the project website in advance of work.
