East Main St. over I-5 & OR 66 over CORP Bridges

Construction Cost: \$2.7 million

Construction Schedule: April-August

2023

Problem: These two close bridges in Ashland need a structural deck overlay. Poor and separated (delaminated) concrete will be repaired and the entire deck will receive a new concrete overlay.



Repair and impacts: Beginning April 2023, the East Main Street Bridge over I-5 will be closed for up to 5 weeks for daytime deck repairs and new concrete deck overlay. This bridge is structurally deficient based on the poor deck condition. There is a nearby detour using Ashland Street to Tolman Creek Road to East Main Street.

Beginning in late May thru August, the Oregon 66, Ashland Street over CORP Bridge will be under construction. It will remain open for deck repairs. Expect single lane traffic in each direction throughout the duration of the project as the contractor works on one-half of the bridge at a time. Due to its width, the length of time to repair this bridge is expected to be up to 10 weeks. Work will be during daytime hours. However, some night-time work for some critical construction, such as applying the deck overlay.
