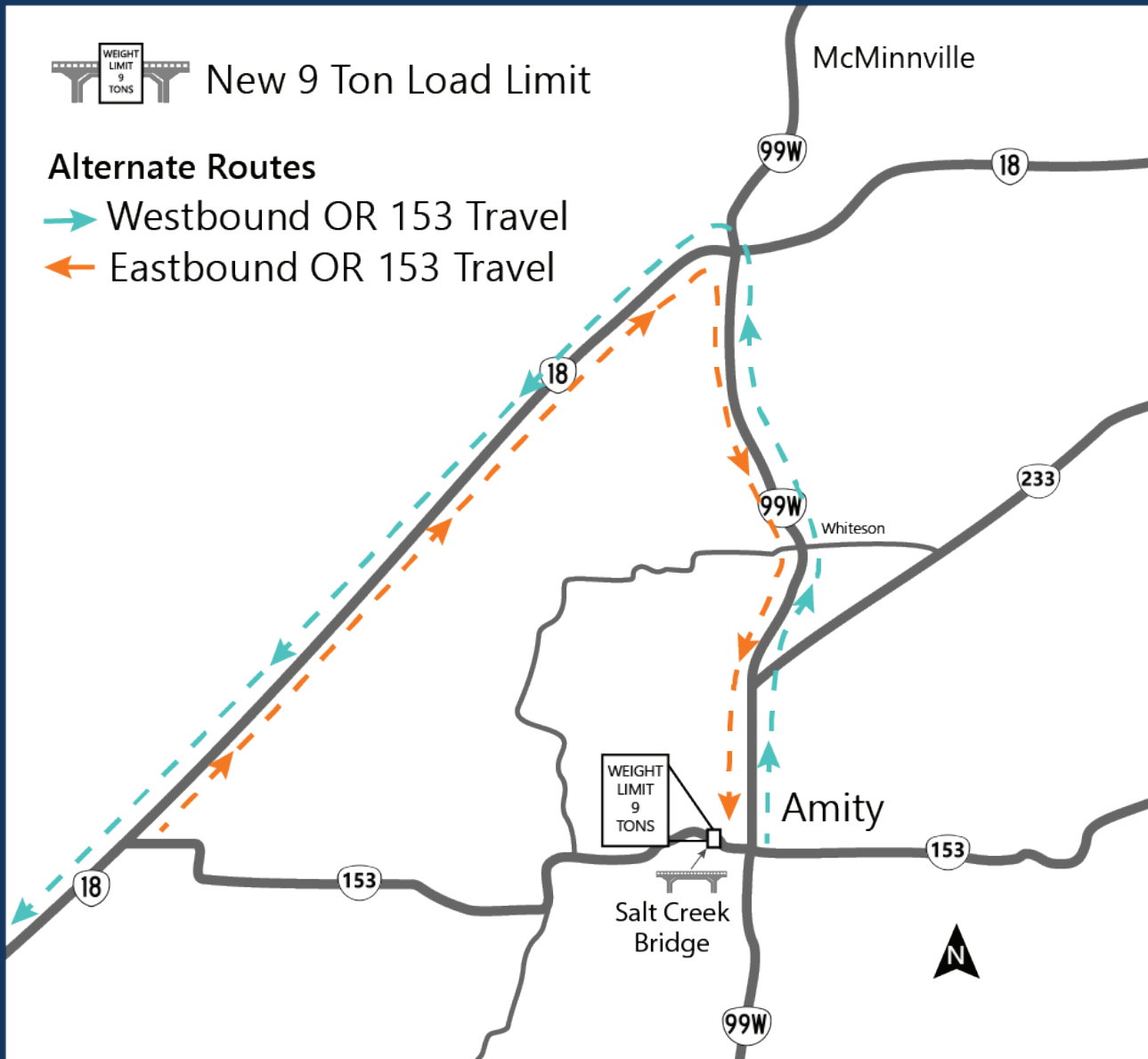
OR 153 Salt Creek Bridge LOAD LIMIT RESTRICTION

New Weight Restriction Posting:

This Salt Creek Bridge is a 70 year old timber bridge that was built to last 50 years. Although maintenance and repairs have extended its life, the most recent bridge inspection found that critical parts have deteriorated to the point where vehicle weight (loads) needs to be restricted to no more than 9 tons. Continuing to make repairs is no longer an option. The bridge is scheduled to be replaced in 2022.

The weight restrictions apply to vehicles such as medium and large trucks, school buses and large farm equipment. Alternate routes are shown on the map. Local Yamhill County roads may not be recommended for large trucks.
