U.S. 97 at NE Chestnut St. (Madras)

Project Description

Install pedestrian refuge island at the intersection of U.S. 97 and NE Cedar Street in Madras, including illumination and crossing signage.

This project was originally planned at NE Chestnut Street but has been moved further south to NE Cedar and is now part of the larger K21653 U.S. 97: Earl St - Colfax Ln (Madras) project.

Purpose and Need

This location is within the City of Madras but there is no pedestrian or bike infrastructure to the north of Oak Street. The lack of safe crossing options is a concern for people in the area who use these alternate modes of transportation.

Proposed Solutions

Install a pedestrian a refuge island, illumination, and crossing signage to give pedestrians safer access when crossing the highway.

Anticipated Benefits

Installing a pedestrian refuge island with illumination and signing will make navigating this area safer for everyone, especially people attempting to cross the highway.

Drivers will be alerted to pedestrians and bicyclists trying to cross the highway. Signs and lighting will remind them that they are entering an urban area.
