

U.S. 97: Veterans Way - SW Yew Ave (Redmond)

Deschutes County

Project Description

Design work only. Construction phase will need additional funding.

This project will include paving, creating sidewalks with accessible curb ramps, installing a new traffic signal at U.S. 97 and Pumice Avenue along with more corridor upgrades to utilities.

Purpose and Need

The existing pavement is failing and needs immediate attention. Sidewalks need to be updated with current ADA compliant curb ramps, Bicycle facilities need to be improved, and the current traffic signal is aging.

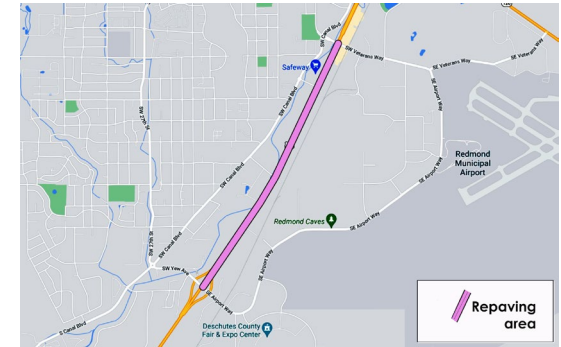
Proposed Solutions

The work in this area will include new ADA compliant curb ramps at intersections in the project area, as well as other improvements such as medians, storm water facilities, sidewalks, protected bicycle lanes, and enhanced pedestrian crossings.

Anticipated Benefits

Paving will extend the lifespan of the road while providing a safer driving surface.

Sidewalks and ADA compliant curb ramps will make the area easier and safer to navigate by people using alternate modes of transportation and those who rely on accessibility in our transportation system.
