### **Annual STIF Low-Income Mitigation Report**

- Due date for the first annual report is August 14, 2020
- Purpose of report
  - Actions taken by any PTSPs located within the area of that QE to mitigate the impact of the STIF tax on passengers who reside in low-income communities
- Roles and responsibilities
  - PTSPs submit form to their QE
  - QE completes cover letter and form, bundles all PTSP forms, and submits consolidated report to ODOT



### **Low-Income Impact Mitigation Cover Letter**

- QE to complete a cover letter
  - Explain how the QE defines and identifies passengers in low-income communities
  - List of PTSPs who have submitted the Low-Income Impact Mitigation Forms
- Submit cover letter and attach all Low-Income Impact Mitigation Forms to ODOT
- QE to coordinate with PTSPs on receiving submissions in advance

QEs are responsible for bundling and submitting reports from all PTSPs in their area of responsibility. The QE report is due to ODOT no later than 60 days after the end of each Fiscal Year.
