Wheeler County Community Transportation	4	\$20,000	Demand-response transit service to healthcare destinations.
Malheur County	5	\$20,000	Demand-response transit service to VA and VA-covered facilities.
Jefferson County	4	\$250,000	Demand-response transit rides for veterans throughout Jefferson County, to reach veterans that Community Connectors and fixed-route transit can't reach.
Tillamook County Transportation District	2A	\$350,000	Demand-response transit rides for veterans and mileage reimbursement for veterans who can access a car.
Basin Transit Service Transportation District	4	\$55,664	Fare-free vet rides on fixed route, paratransit, demand-response and VA hospital shuttle.
The Klamath Tribes	4	\$65,954	Demand-response service, with mobility management in coordination with Basin TSTD. Mostly serving vets in highly rural areas of Klamath County outside of the BTSTD service area.
Coos County Area Transportation District	3	\$150,000	Demand-response transit service and scheduled shuttles to healthcare destinations in Coos Bay, Florence, North Bend, Bandon and others.
Rogue Valley Transportation District	3	\$135,000	Go Vets Oregon statewide veteran outreach to connect veterans to transportation options around Oregon. <i>Funding from ODOT's Technical Resource Center.</i>
