Subject: 2021 Update of the 2017
Coordinated Transit Plan

SILETZ TRIBAL COUNCIL
Resolution

WHEREAS, the Siletz Tribal Council is empowered to exercise the legislative and executive authority of the Confederated Tribes of Siletz Indians of Oregon pursuant to Article IV, Section 1 of the Siletz Constitution approved June 13, 1979, by the Acting Deputy Commissioner of Indian Affairs; and

WHEREAS, the Portland Area BIA Office has annual road construction funds available for allocation, and which require projects to be identified and prioritized in the Tribes' current transportation system plan (TSP) (Res. 2010-192), and transportation improvement program (TIP); and the Tribe has updated the TIP with FY 2017 Tribal Transportation Plan Government to Government full funding; and

WHEREAS, ODOT PTD (Public Transit Division) recipients of STF (Special Transit Funds) and STIF (Special Transit Improvement Funds) funds are required to participate in regional service coordination and to have an adopted 'Coordinated Plan' to continue to receive this transit funding; and


WHEREAS, the 2017 Coordinated Plan, approved under Resolution 2017-371, has been updated for current STF and STIF transit funding purposes in January 2021, and will be recognized for three years (to 2023) by ODOT's Public Transit Division; now

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Siletz Tribal Council authorizes the January 2021 update of the 2017 Confederated Tribes of Siletz Indians Coordinated Plan (Coordinated Human Services-Public Transportation Plan) for STF, STIF and other transit funding purposes; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tribal Chairman, Vice-Chairman, General Manager, or his designee are authorized to sign agreements and make modifications and amendments relating to this Plan.


