
Oregon 140 @ Atlantic Ave. Roundabout

Total Projected Cost:

\$2.2M

Construction Schedule: 2019

Overview: Jackson County will be extending Foothill Rd. north to Oregon 140 to connect at Atlantic Ave. on the north side of Lake of the Woods Highway. A safe intersection must be built to accommodate the



project.

Problem: High speed, rural intersections are safety hazards to the driving public. Traffic signals, the typical intersection tool, trades T-bone crashes for rear-end crashes, yet still cause life changing injuries and fatalities.

Project Description: Jackson County plans to extend Foothill Rd. to better connect this "beltline" road to Oregon 140 instead of the existing problematic intersections of Corey Rd. and Kershaw Rd.

To compliment the county's new roadway, ODOT would construct a highway roundabout that would allow for safer mobility through the intersection.

Kershaw Road/ Oregon 140 intersection would be re-designed as a right-in right out, left in.
