

U.S. 101: Parkview Dr. to Easy St. Sidewalks (Brookings)

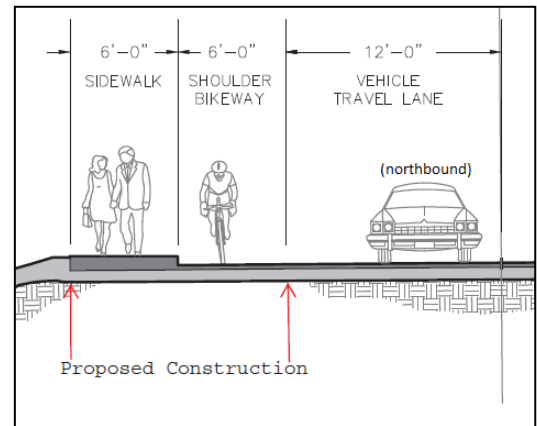


What is the problem?

In the residential area of northeast Brookings, there are currently no sidewalks along U.S. Highway 101 between Parkview Drive and Easy Street. The shoulder width and condition is irregular, which limits pedestrian access and connectivity and makes travel difficult for bicycles.

What is the solution?

This project will construct a 6-foot wide ADA compliant sidewalk and a 6-foot wide shoulder bikeway between Parkview Drive and Easy Street.



This project will fill gaps in the transportation system and connect different modes of transportation to key destinations. It will provide safer and more accessible facilities for pedestrians, better access to the bus stop south of the project limits, a safer bikeway that connects to existing bike lanes, and it will help reduce conflict points for motor vehicles.
