2024 -2027 STIP Preservation Program

Region 1 helps develop and scope projects for two types of Preservation funding:

- ODOT Highway Preservation Program for pavement improvement projects on ODOT's Highway network, and:
- Interstate Maintenance Preservation For pavement improvements on the Interstate system.

Region 1 manages \$22.3 million in ODOT Highway Preservation funds and the Interstate Maintenance funds are managed at the statewide level. Both preservation programs follow a similar project selection process that is driven by asset condition data. Final prioritization and selection is coordinated by regional leadership and the statewide preservation program
