2	Adding or deleting any phase (except CN) of an approved project below Full Amendment #3	Online via Program & Funding
3	Combining two or more approved projects into one or splitting an approved project into two or more, or splitting part of an approved project to a new one.	Online via Program & Funding
4	Splitting a new project out of an approved program-specific pool of funds (but not reserves for future projects) or adding funds to an existing project from a bucket or reserve if the project was selected through a specific process (i.e. ARTS, Local Bridge...)	Online via Program & Funding

**Amendment Definition**

An amendment is a change to project information and costs. For financial changes, this applies to unobligated phases or phases which have been obligated and have additional financial change within the same federal fiscal year

**Public Comment Notes**

For public comment, project updates need to be provided at a public meeting. Requirements are the project needs to be listed as part of the agenda and allow for the public to comment on the changes.
