RE: 2021 Schedule of Fines on Violations, Effective February 1, 2021

In response to Measure 110, the Office of the State Court Administrator (OSCA) updated the Schedule of Fines on Violations, which lists the presumptive, minimum, and maximum fines for classified violations and many common specific fine violations. The measure was approved by Oregon voters in November 2020.

Measure 110 reduces penalties for possession of controlled substance offenses from a misdemeanor to a new Class E violation. A Class E violation is punishable by a maximum fine of \$100. In lieu of paying a fine, a person may submit to the court verification that they received a health assessment at an addiction recovery center within 45 days of receiving a citation. These changes go into effect on February 1, 2021.

The attached schedule is effective February 1, 2021, and replaces the previous Schedule of Fines on Violations (SOF-20). This schedule is posted to the Oregon Judicial Department website at <http://www.courts.oregon.gov/Pages/fees.aspx>.

The Schedule of Fines is intended to serve as a helpful guide to courts and law enforcement and is not a substitute for reading the actual law. Justice and municipal courts should contact their local legal counsel or court associations for interpretation of the law and how it affects their local court policies and procedures.
