

All non-training activities are available if you are interested. Everyone will be responsible for their own transportation, lodging reservations, food, and supervision of children if they attend. Sunday free lunch is available. Park reservations can be made as early as six months in advance. Space fills quickly. The park is beautiful, clean, has lots of amenities, Wi-Fi, a second connected campground at Jasper Point, multiple boat ramps and moorages. Day use parking is \$10/day, but unnecessary if you have an annual park pass or campground/cabin/RV reservation at the park. Second vehicles will be subject to the day use parking fee.

- Park quiet time is 10pm.
