Interested in becoming an Oregon Work Zone Traffic Control Flagger? Below is what you need to know.

Requirements for obtaining your Certification of Completion flagger card:

- 1) Complete a four-hour class by a Certified Flagger Trainer
- 2) Received a passing test score of 80% or higher

The Certification Class includes the following books:

- ODOT's Temporary Traffic Control Handbook for operations of 3 days or less
- Work Zone Traffic Control and Flagger Training Program Student Workbook

Taking a Certification Class

The list is alphabetized by city. It also includes a few instructors who offer online courses (in ***bold italics***). Each instructor manages their own class schedule, and class prices vary. All course materials are provided in class.

Upon completion of the course your instructor will send your registration form to Chemeketa. Once received, Chemeketa will send you an official Certified Flagger card.

Keep in mind that your flagger card is required to be on you at all times while flagging. We want to keep Oregon roadways safe by making sure all work zones are operated "by the book."
