Get to Know Oregon Crosswalk Laws 🕍



When Driving:

Under Oregon law (OR 811.028) every intersection is a legal crosswalk. You must safely stop for people showing intent to cross the street at a marked or unmarked crosswalk or at a marked mid-block crosswalk.

When Walking:

Signal your intent to cross at marked and unmarked intersections, or marked midblock crosswalks. Show intent to cross by extending your hand, foot, wheelchair, cane, crutch or bicycle into the roadway. Drivers should yield right of way. For your safety, make sure vehicles moving in all lanes and in both directions have stopped before proceeding.
