



EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 22-22

**CONTINUING THE GOVERNOR'S ADVISORY COMMITTEE ON
MOTORCYCLE SAFETY; REPLACING EXECUTIVE ORDERS 99-09
AND 16-01.**

The Governor's Advisory Committee on Motorcycle Safety (Committee) was informally established by Governor Vic Atiyeh in 1981, and subsequently formalized and extended in Executive Orders 99-09 and 16-01 by Governors John Kitzhaber and Kate Brown. The Committee represents the voice of Oregon motorcyclists and advises the Governor of the State of Oregon on safety for motorcyclists and those with whom they share the road in Oregon. I find good cause to continue this committee for a further four years, as directed below.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED AND DIRECTED:

1. The Governor's Advisory Committee on Motorcycle Safety (Committee) is continued. The committee shall consist of not more than eight members appointed by the Governor. Committee members shall serve at the pleasure of the Governor for four year terms as those terms were initially staggered. In case of a vacancy for any cause, the Governor shall make an appointment for the unexpired term.
2. The Committee shall focus its efforts upon rider education, drinking and riding, road hazards unique to motorcycles, motorist awareness of motorcycles, sharing the road and other safety issues. It shall advise the Governor and the Governor's Highway Safety Representative regarding motorcycle safety issues and legislation that is in the best interest of the Oregon transportation public.
3. The Committee shall submit an annual report to the Governor outlining the Committee's accomplishments, goals and mission statement.
4. The Committee shall elect a chairperson by majority vote. The chairperson shall designate a vice-chair to carry out the duties of the chair in the chair's absence. The chair may designate subcommittees as needed.
5. The Committee shall meet in accord with a schedule approved by a majority of its members and shall meet on special occasions at the call of the chair. Five voting members shall constitute a quorum. A vote of the majority shall be sufficient for all actions of the Committee.
6. The Committee shall meet in accord with a schedule approved by a majority of its members and shall meet on special occasions at the call of the chair. Five voting members shall constitute a quorum. A vote of the majority shall be sufficient for all actions of the Committee.
