




Health Systems Division Liaison Report April 2023



A total of **839** screenings and referrals to DUII services were completed in **January**. This represents:

- An increase of 22% as compared to January 2022
- An increase of 22% year-to-date compared to 2022
- A decrease of 20% year-to-date compared to 2020

DUII Services Modernization Initiative Update:

 Given the significant leadership changes at OHA, we felt it prudent to delay the start of the workgroups to allow time for our new leadership to be brought up to speed on the work of the DUII Services Modernization Initiative and its role in reducing DUII recidivism and health inequities.
