




Health Systems Division Liaison Report May 2023



The graph has been updated to include:

- 2019 to indicate the pre-COVID baseline
- 2020 to indicate the decline in screening related to COVID
- 2022 to indicate the previous year's screenings
- 2023 to indicate the current year's screenings

A total of **758** screenings and referrals to DUII services were completed in **February**. This represents:

- An increase of 7% year-to-date compared to 2022
- A decrease of 20% year-to-date compared to 2020
- A decrease of 23% year-to-date compared to 2019

DUII Services Modernization Initiative Update:

• Given the significant leadership changes at OHA, we felt it prudent to **delay the start of the workgroups until Fall of 2023** to allow time for our new leadership to be brought up to speed on the work of the DUII Services Modernization Initiative and its role in reducing DUII recidivism and health inequities.
