

The North Idaho Problem

• 2013 to 2018: 51% Region 1 fatal crashes caused by impaired driver

 2015 to 2017: 60% <u>Kootenai County</u> fatal crashes caused by impaired driver.

Nationally 29% fatal crashes caused by impaired driver

• 2017: Kootenai County saw approx. 8% increase in impaired crashes while Idaho saw 9% reduction



- The solution might not be where the problem is








Successful First Year

 - 66% reduction in alcohol related fatalities county wide






