












FELONY AND MISDEMEANOR DUII: FINES IMPOSED AND COLLECTED

2020	\$5,251,138	\$2,648,910	50%
2021	\$4,907,458	\$1,883,521	38%
2022	\$3,009,602	\$791,318	26%
