OTSC History

- Highway Safety Act of 1966: OR Transportation Safety Commission
- 1991: Commission and Representatives moved to ODOT
 - Replaced the commission with a committee
- Commission staff then became employees, forming the TSO
- ORS 802.300: Decision-making responsibilities were determined
- DMV Administrator serves as the Governor's Representative for Highway Safety (GR)



Purpose: Advisory Role to the Oregon Transportation Commission








- Motorcycle Safety
- Pedestrian/Bicyclist Safety
- Ignition Interlock Program
- Teen Driver Education

Facilitates in planning and approval of Oregon's Triennial Highway Safety Plan, or 3HSP for BEHAVIORAL COUNTERMEASURES (Federal & State funds)

- Hosts planning sessions
- Sponsors annual Transportation Safety Conference
- Serves on task forces or as liaisons to other safetyrelated work groups

OTSC BY-LAWS: Committee Responsibilities

- Regular on-time attendance
- Notify staff if unable to attend
- Prepare for meetings by reviewing minutes and other materials before meeting
- Understand democratic process

- Examine relevant information before making decisions
- Committee serves the public interest
- Testify before Legislature on behalf of committee when asked to do so

ODOT-DMV-TRANSPORTATION SAFETY OFFICE

- State Highway Safety Office
- Serves as staff to the OTSC
- Administers fed/state grant awards made to partners
- Awarded grant projects:
 - Data-driven
 - Proven countermeasure(s)
 - Address risky driving behaviors, or the 'Behavioral' side of safety (not infrastructure)
 - Goal: Zero fatalities/serious injuries

- Staffing:
 - TSO Manager(s)
 - Program Analysts = SME's
 - Support Staff
 - Grants Assistant
