**GUIDANCE FOR FINAL ASSESSMENTS**

The final assessment is the last chance to assess a student's ability to make correct decisions and actions in regard to their lifetime of safe driving. There is to be no coaching anywhere during the official assessment portion of their final drive. Coaching and Cueing both bring into question the ownership of that teen to have made the correct decision.

Vocabulary/Terms that should not be used on a final assessment are:

- “When it is safe and legal”
- “What is your Target?” “Tell me what lane position you are in”
- “At the stop sign or stop light or traffic signal turn right/left/stop”
