POLICY 050917 GUIDANCE FOR FINAL ASSESSMENTS

The final assessment is the last chance to assess a student's ability to make correct decisions and actions in regard to their lifetime of safe driving. There is to be no coaching anywhere <u>during the official assessment portion of their final drive</u>. Coaching and Cueing both bring into question the ownership of that teen to have made the correct decision.

Vocabulary/Terms that should <u>not</u> be used on a final assessment are:

- "When it is safe and legal"
- "What is your Target?" "Tell me what lane position you are in"
- "At the stop sign or stop light or traffic signal turn right/left/stop"
