### **SIGNIFICANT REPORT ITEMS**

- The October 2025 meeting of Governor's Advisory Committee (GAC) on DUII was held at the Department of Public Safety Standards and Training (DPSST) in Salem, OR. The meeting featured a presentation from Dr. Daniel Hoover from OHSU who specializes in Addiction and Mental Health. Dr. Hoover provided an overview of the efforts related to DUII recidivism and individuals suffering from addiction and mental health issues. This is an area of interest to the committee as it relates to recent studies and reports of increases in DUII re-offenders who abuse alcohol and other drugs and have mental health issues. The presentation was informative and well received by the committee.

### **COMMITTEE ACTION ITEMS / RECOMMENDATIONS**

- Ryan Stone from ODOT TSO reported on their efforts to update the DUII Data Book for Oregon Counties. The last update was conducted in 2016. It was agreed within the committee that the document is very useful in identifying and addressing DUII issues in each of the Oregon counties and provides valuable information for various roadway safety groups in the efforts to reduce DUII and related crashes. The committee members were tasked with reviewing the most recent document on-line and to submit recommendations to Mr. Stone. Two recommendations made during the meeting were to include data on repeat offenders and county DUII breath test data supplied by the Oregon State Police.
