- Meet federal requirements

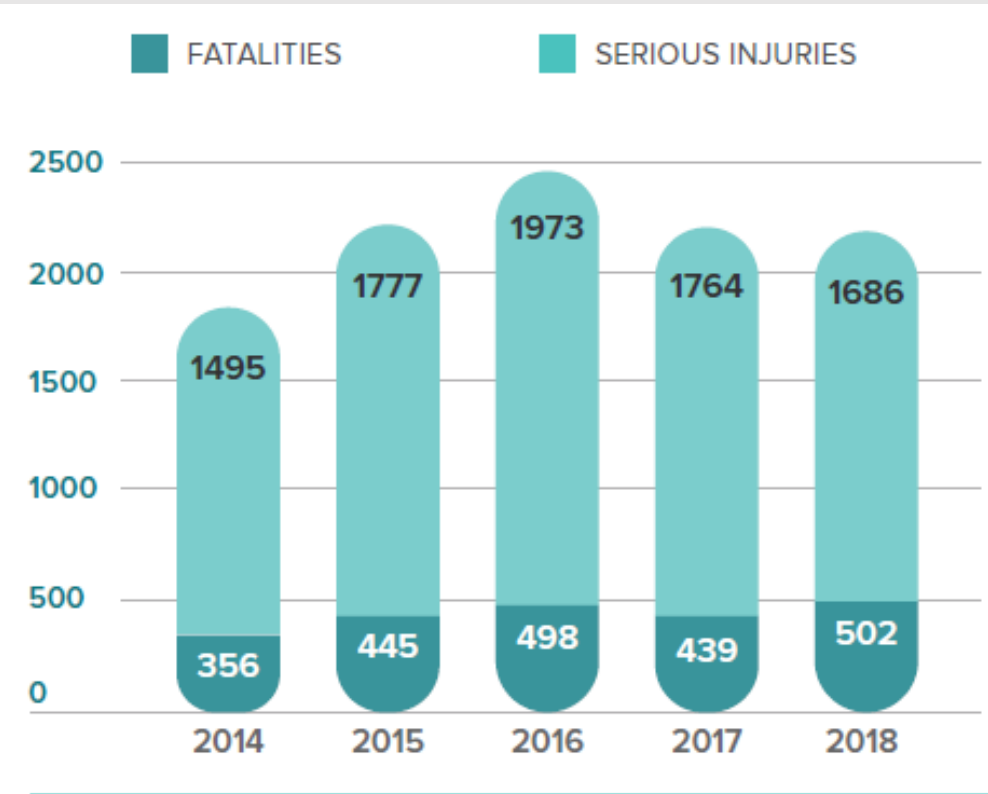


FIGURE 4 FATALITIES AND SERIOUS INJURIES (2014-2018)

TSAP VISION

Oregon envisions no deaths or life-changing injuries on Oregon's transportation system by 2035.

- Improve safety through design
- Prioritize safety of vulnerable travelers
- Improve data reporting timelines
- Address traffic safety enforcement issues
- Improve implementation and accountability
