# Application for Salvage Title

REMARKS:

## FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS ON THE BACK OF THIS FORM

**A salvage title must be obtained for vehicles:** (ORS 819.010; 819.012, 819.014 and 819.016)

- Declared a total loss by an insurer who is obligated to cover the loss (this includes damaged and un-recovered stolen); **or**
- That have sustained damage not covered by an insurer and the estimated repair cost is equal to at least 80% of the retail market value prior to the damage. "Retail market value" is defined as the amount shown in publications used by financial institutions (e.g., banks and lenders) in this state; **or**
- Wrecked, disassembled, dismantled, if the intention is to repair or rebuild the vehicle, transfer the vehicle to anyone other than a licensed dismantler, or use the frame or unibody to repair or construct another vehicle.

**ODOMETER - FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS ON THE BACK OF THIS FORM.** Federal and State laws require that you state the mileage when you transfer ownership of a 2011 or newer model year vehicle, until that vehicle is 20 years old or older. Use this certification when required to provide the odometer disclosure but unable to provide the proper disclosure from the seller. I certify the odometer disclosure listed is true and correct and a disclosure is not available on the required form from the seller. Failure to complete an odometer disclosure or providing a false statement to meet this requirement is a Class C felony under ORS 815.430.

To apply for salvage title in Oregon, the owner must certify by completing and signing the statements below. By signing this application, the owner also acknowledges the survivorship as indicated above. Under Oregon law, it is a crime to knowingly make any false statement on an application for title (ORS 803.070 / ORS 803.385). Both offenses are Class A misdemeanors and are punishable by a jail sentence of up to one year, a fine of up to \$6,250 or both.

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## SALVAGE TITLE APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

To apply for a salvage title, you must submit:

**1. The original title or primary ownership document.**

- If the original Oregon title is lost, destroyed or mutilated, you may choose to check the box on line 15 of this form instead of including an application for replacement title.

**2. Releases of interest from all prior owners, lessors or security interest holders.**

- If you are an insurer who (A) declared the vehicle a total loss, (B) took possession of the vehicle, or (C) took possession of title to the vehicle, your signature on this form certifies that all prior interests have been satisfied **only if**:
  - You submit the original Oregon title or salvage title; **and**
  - You provide all odometer disclosure requirements.

**3. This completed application.**

- The “reference number” box may be completed with your claim or policy number and date of loss you want shown on the salvage title.

**4. An odometer disclosure, if the vehicle is subject to odometer disclosure requirements.**

- The Code of Federal Regulations (CFR) Title 49 Part 580 requires an odometer disclosure if the vehicle is subject. Failure to complete the disclosure or providing false information may result in fines and/or imprisonment.
- The following vehicles are exempt from odometer disclosure: vehicles that are not self-propelled, model year 2010 vehicles or older, model year 2011 and newer vehicles that are at least 20 years old at time of application, vehicles not equipped with an odometer at the time of manufacture, snowmobiles, ATVs and vehicles with a manufacturer's gross vehicle weight rating in excess of 16,000 pounds.
- Unrecovered stolen vehicles are also exempt from odometer disclosure. Salvage title applications for such vehicles must include an Exemption from Odometer Disclosure Requirements (Form 735-6745).
- If providing the odometer disclosure is impossible, explain the reason why on Line 4 of this form – for example, “odometer removed” or “vehicle burnt.” The resulting salvage title will show “Not Readable” in the odometer section.
- An odometer message of “Not Actual” remains on record and will devalue the vehicle.

**5. The \$27 fee.**

Submit the documents and fees to a DMV office, or mail them to:

**Once a salvage title has been issued, the registration and registration plates for the vehicle are no longer valid. A trip permit may be purchased for salvage-titled vehicles.**
