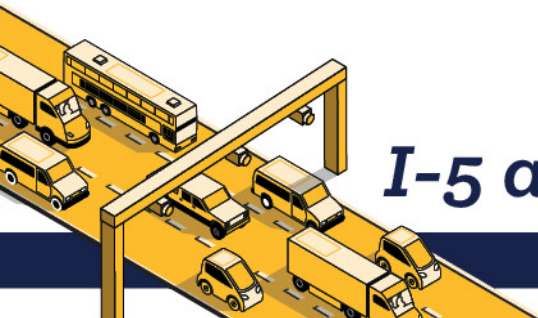

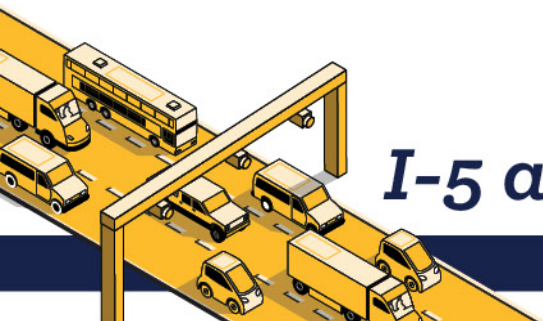

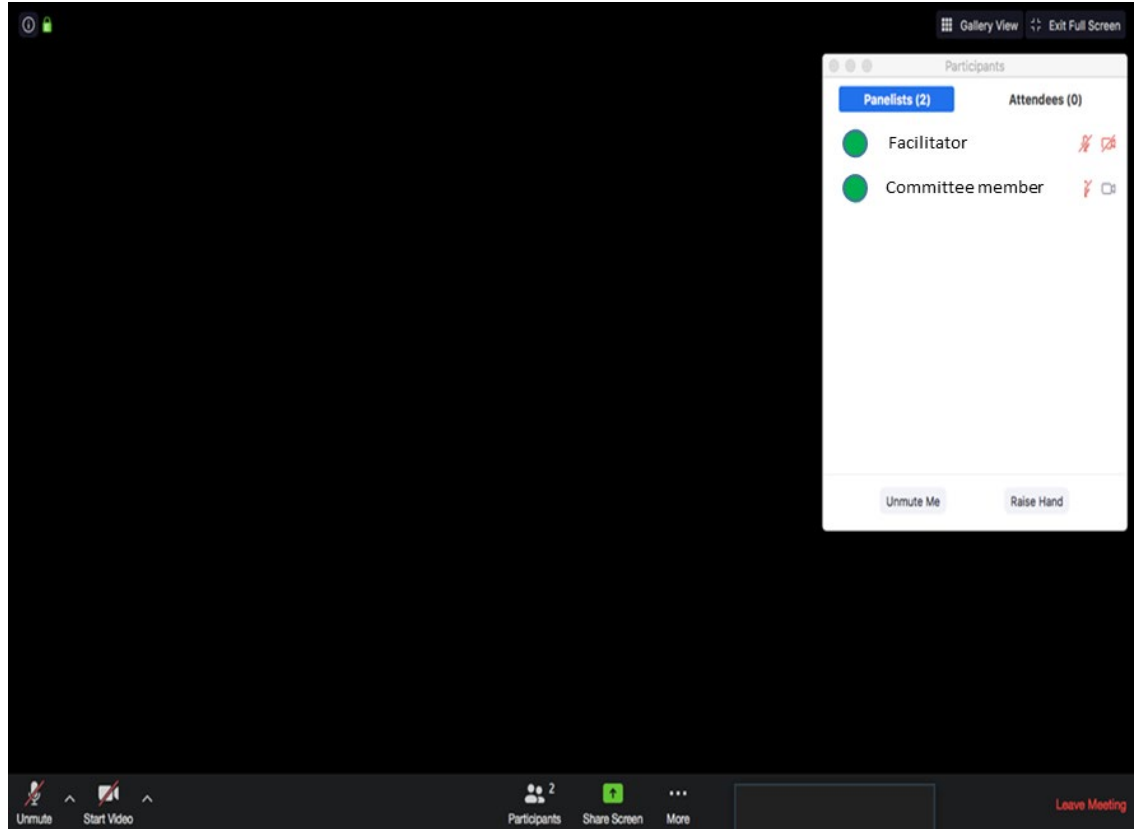

Zoom Etiquette

Make sure your **name is spelled correctly**. To do that, click on participants at the bottom center. It will open the top right pane. You will see a blue box that says rename. If you need to update your name, that is where you do it.

Working Together: Agreements

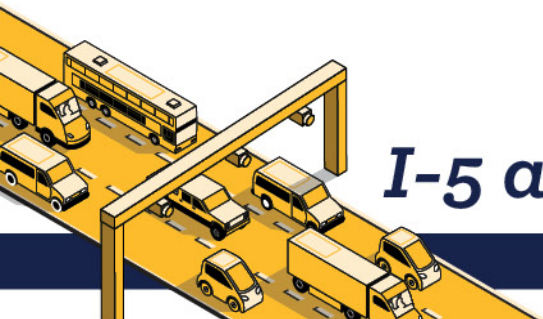
- Listen, believe, and reflect

- Make space, then take space; be concise
- Bring your best thinking into the room
- Attack the problem, not the person
- Disagreement, frustration, and differences of opinion are acknowledged, explored, and addressed
- Any others?

- Breathe normally

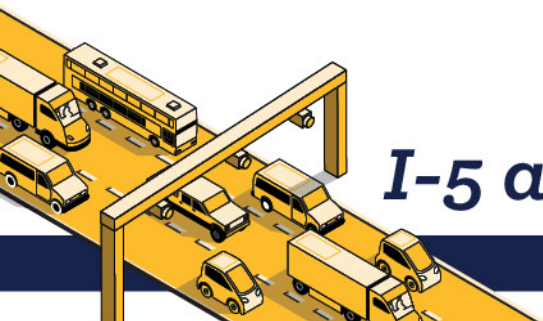

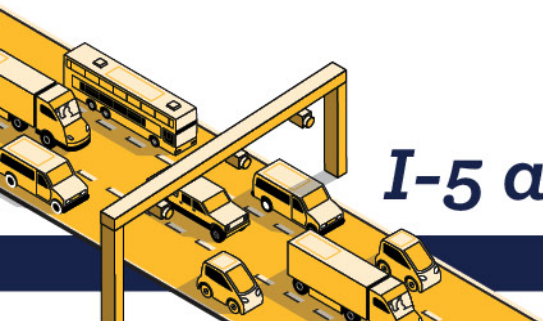

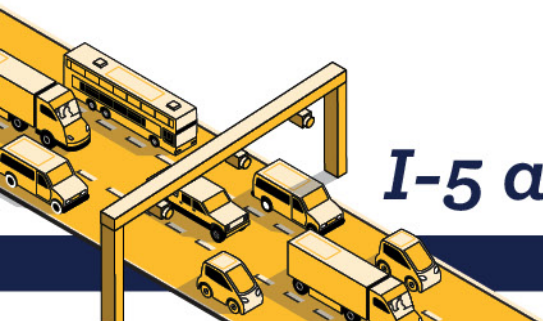

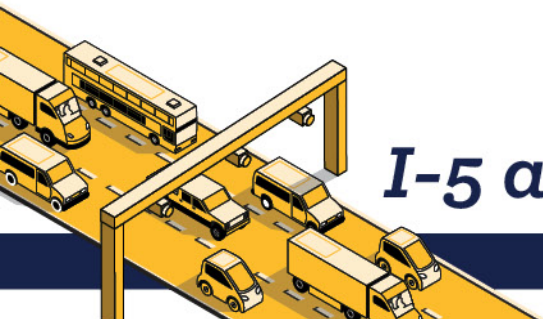

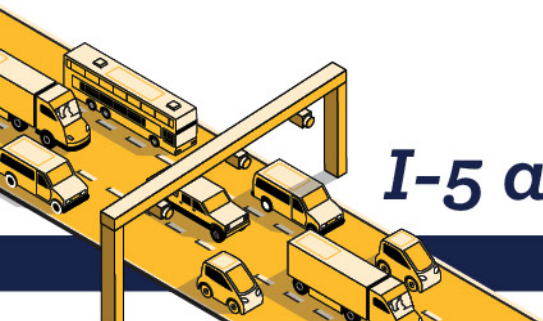

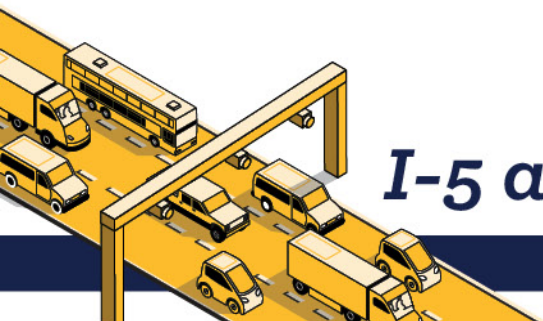
