TOLL RATE SETTING AND ADJUSTMENTS

- Criteria, factors, or goals the Oregon Transportation Commission will use to set rates (low-income toll program is a factor, among others)
- Items adopted in the toll rate schedule
- Toll schedule review and monitoring factors
- Holidays and emergencies
- Pre-completion and post-completion of construction
- Rates by vehicle types (shape/weight)
- How different vehicles will be will be treated (for example, motorcycles and trailers)
- Time of day pricing (variable rates)
- Toll rate schedule per project and rates identified (*The specific rates will not be included in this rulemaking effort, but as a part of the future toll rate setting process that occurs on each project.*)

for tollway maintenance), <u>383.215</u> (use of federal funds), <u>383.225</u> and <u>383.245</u> (toll revenue and bonding), and <u>383.235</u> (reserve accounts)

Oregon rules (OAR) <u>731-040-0052</u> and <u>0053</u> (process for reviewing and approving tolls and toll rates, generally), <u>731-040-0054</u> (additional process for setting toll rates on highways), <u>731-040-0055</u> (additional process for setting toll rates on interstate bridges), <u>731-040-0056</u> and <u>0057</u> (process for adjusting toll rates, generally), <u>731-040-0058</u> (process for adjusting toll rates on highways), and <u>731-040-0059</u> (process for adjusting toll rates on interstate bridges)

DISCOUNTS AND EXEMPTIONS

- Low-income discount enrollment, verification, and recertification process
- Exemptions for public transit, emergency response vehicles, and military vehicles
- Exemptions for Tribal government vehicles and members (*This will be addressed through a separate government-to-government consultation process.*)

Existing rules and laws

- Federal law Chapter 23, <u>Section 129</u> (toll roads, bridges, tunnels, and ferries)
- Oregon law (ORS) <u>399.145</u> (military)

NEW TOLL PROJECTS

- Fees for new toll project applications
- Review process for ODOT and the Oregon Transportation Commission to accept the project for further study
- Review process for toll projects on Interstate Bridges (These will be revised through a separate process for the Interstate Bridge Project rulemaking and rate setting.)

Existing rules and laws

 Federal law Chapter 23, <u>Section 129</u> (toll roads, bridges, tunnels, and ferries) and <u>Section 166</u> (high-occupancy vehicle facilities)





- Oregon law (ORS) <u>381.005-824</u> (Interstate bridges), <u>383.001</u> (basis for tolling), <u>383.004</u> (process to establish tolls), and <u>383.015</u> (evaluation factors to authorize a project)
- Oregon rules (OAR) <u>731-040-0030</u> (application for new toll projects) and <u>731-040-0050</u> (process to evaluate and authorize new toll projects)
