Allows the Adjutant General to facilitate, assist or coordinate in the mobilization of the Oregon National Guard under Title 10 of the United States Code or Title 32 of the United States Code under an authority other than the Governor, only if the active service is for certain listed reasons.</p>

Establishes the Task Force on Responding to Veterans in Crisis and directs the task force to submit a report to the interim committee of the Legislative Assembly related to emergency management and veterans no later than September 15, 2026.</p>

<p>Relating to veterans; prescribing an effective date. Declares that it is the goal of the Legislative Assembly to fund the Department of Veterans' Affairs in an amount that is not less than \$10,000,000, from the General Fund, in 2015 dollars, adjusted for inflation.</p>
