

COVID-19 Safety Measures

As of March 4, 2020

In response to the coronavirus (COVID-19) outbreak, the CDC is recommending that all communities take measures to reduce the risk of infection. To help ensure the safety of all who live, work at and visit the Home, the following safety measures, are in effect:

VISITATION

- ▶ Non-essential visits from community members are discouraged.
- ▶ Hours for essential visits will be from 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. until further notice.
- ▶ All visitors will be screened for symptoms and/or possible exposure to COVID-19 upon entry.
- ▶ Entry will be accessible only via the main entrance. All alternate entry doors will be locked but will still allow the ability to exit for safety.
- ▶ Use of hand sanitizing stations are provided and required use upon building entry.
- ▶ Skype Visitations are encouraged. Please contact the Activities Director at 541-296-7190, ext. 242 to arrange face-to-face visitations via Skype.

ADMISSION

- ▶ Admission of new residents is currently on hold until further notice.

ACTIVITIES

- ▶ Large group activities and outside entertainers are canceled.
- ▶ Gift shop will be closed.
- ▶ Beauty Salon remains open. Staff will schedule appointments for residents and the salon will be sanitized between appointments.
- ▶ Café / Grub Club will remain open.
 - Grub Club will not offer window service.
 - Alternate Grub Club meal and snack service is being developed.
- ▶ Outings are canceled.
 - Essential individual resident outings may occur on a case-by-case basis.
