S - Specific What EXACT goal(s) do you wish to accomplish?

M - Measurable How will you measure progress or know you have reached your goal(s)?

A - Attainable What skills or outside help will you need to reach your goal(s)? R - Relevant Is the goal worthwhile? Is it the right time to accomplish it? **T** - Timely When will you complete the goal(s)? When will you work on it? **NOTE to Applicants**: scoring on the goals and objectives is based on identifying AT LEAST one goal and one objective. identifying multiple goals/objectives will not increase the score.

However, if there are multiple goals/objectives be sure to clearly identify each one and how it will be accomplished.
